"Panta Rhei of Fowey" is an ideal warm-water charter yacht and ideal for groups of up to 4 guests. She has **3 double cabins with en-suite heads/showers** (the forward cabin is huge) and a very light and airy interior with excellent forced ventilation. The large cockpit is shaded by a full-length Bimini cover and provides a perfect outdoor lounging and dining area, while bather access to the sea is easy via the stern and underwater bathing ladder.

"Panta Rhei" was originally designed and built in 1995 for a very experienced Dutch Admirals Cup yachtsman who wanted a fast cruising yacht to sail in and between the Mediterranean and Caribbean with his family. Having retired from racing, he called on the services of Rolf Vrolijk (designer of "Alinghi", the Americas Cup holder) to design the yacht incorporating many of his own ideas resulting from a lifetime of sailing. The Vrolijk design team had a vast amount of experience in designing this type of yacht and suggested the yacht be built at the Dutch yard of Kesteloo, who specialise in building custom designed vessels in aluminum with composite decks. This designer/builder combination and the use of a full carbon-fibre rig resulted in a very strong and light yacht with excellent sailing performance and one that was comfortable and could be confidently handled by one person.

The yacht is offered for charter in the Eastern Mediterranean and Adriatic with Geoff Parsons as skipper assisted by a cook/hostess. Geoff is a very experienced and well-respected charter skipper in the Mediterranean and Caribbean, with well over 150,000 sea miles under his belt and an intimate knowledge of his cruising grounds.
